### **Big Walk and Wheel**

The Big Walk and Wheel, a virtual competition encouraging schools across the country to promote sustainable journeys to school, completed on the last day of term, with Bosvigo coming 458<sup>th</sup> out of 2,772 registered schools. On average, just under 60% of our journeys were by walking, scooting or cycling, which was a great effort considering the wet weather in the second half of March.

### LKS2 Production

It was 'Lights, camera, action!' for Years 3 and 4 last week when they performed their Ancient Egyptians show for families last week. The three classes put their production together in just two weeks and can be very proud of their performances, particularly as this was the first time they had performed on stage in front of an audience.



### Cross Country Area Finals

Our cross-country season came to a thrilling end last week with both the mid-Cornwall finals and the Cornwall finals taking place.

On Monday, eight runners from across Key Stage 2 took part in some very fast races at Helston Community College. All eight ran brilliantly, with three qualifying for the County Finals on Thursday at Newquay Sports Centre.

The standard of running was incredibly high on the windy fields at Newquay, but Maisie, Lily and Conor all ran superbly. Maisie won a bronze medal for finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Year 4 girls race, whilst Lily came 34<sup>th</sup> out of 82 in the same race. Conor competed in the Year 6 boys race and can be very proud of finishing 22<sup>nd</sup> out of 84.





## DT fun and learning across the school

There was a real hands-on feel about the school in the last week of term and there was lots of fun being had with designing and making all the way through the school.

In Foundation Stage, Classes 1 and 2 were busy making chocolate nests and truffles, whilst also creating paper baskets to carry their treats.

In Key Stage 1, Classes 3, 4 and 5 were making healthy smoothies. They prepared their own ingredients and had great fun testing one another's creations.

Concentration was required in Lower Key Stage 2, where children were completing two Ancient Egyptian tasks – making canopic jars from papier mâché and then sewing decorative collars.

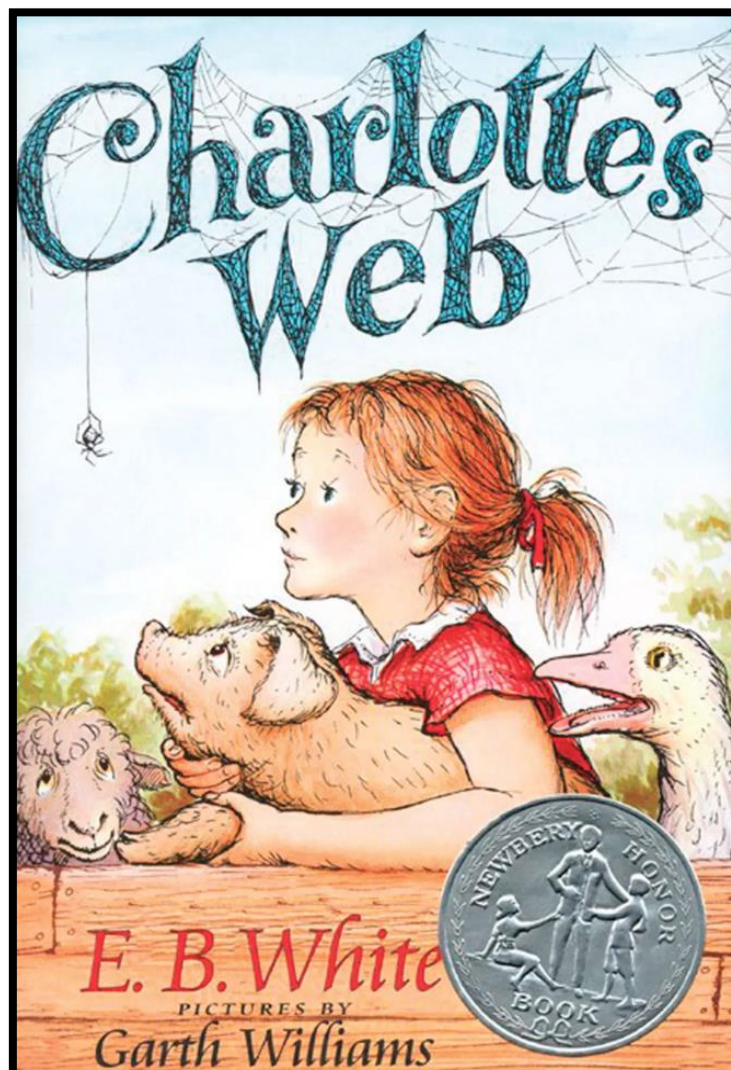

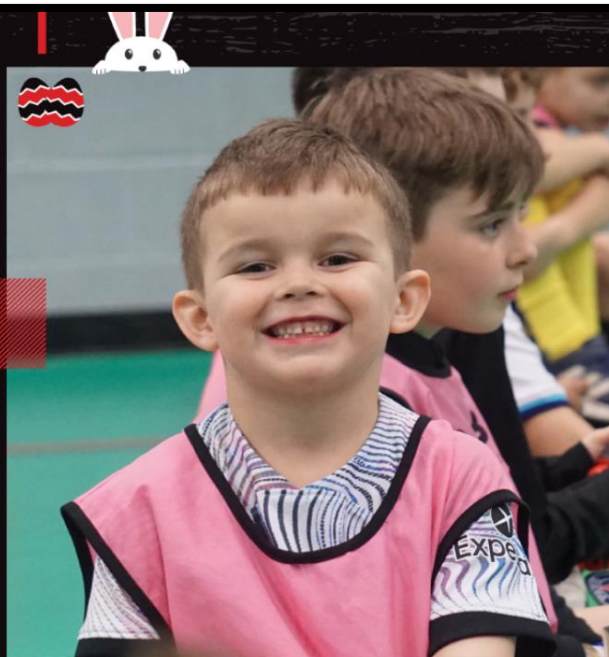
