Children in UKS2 really enjoyed their first Tag Rugby session of the term.



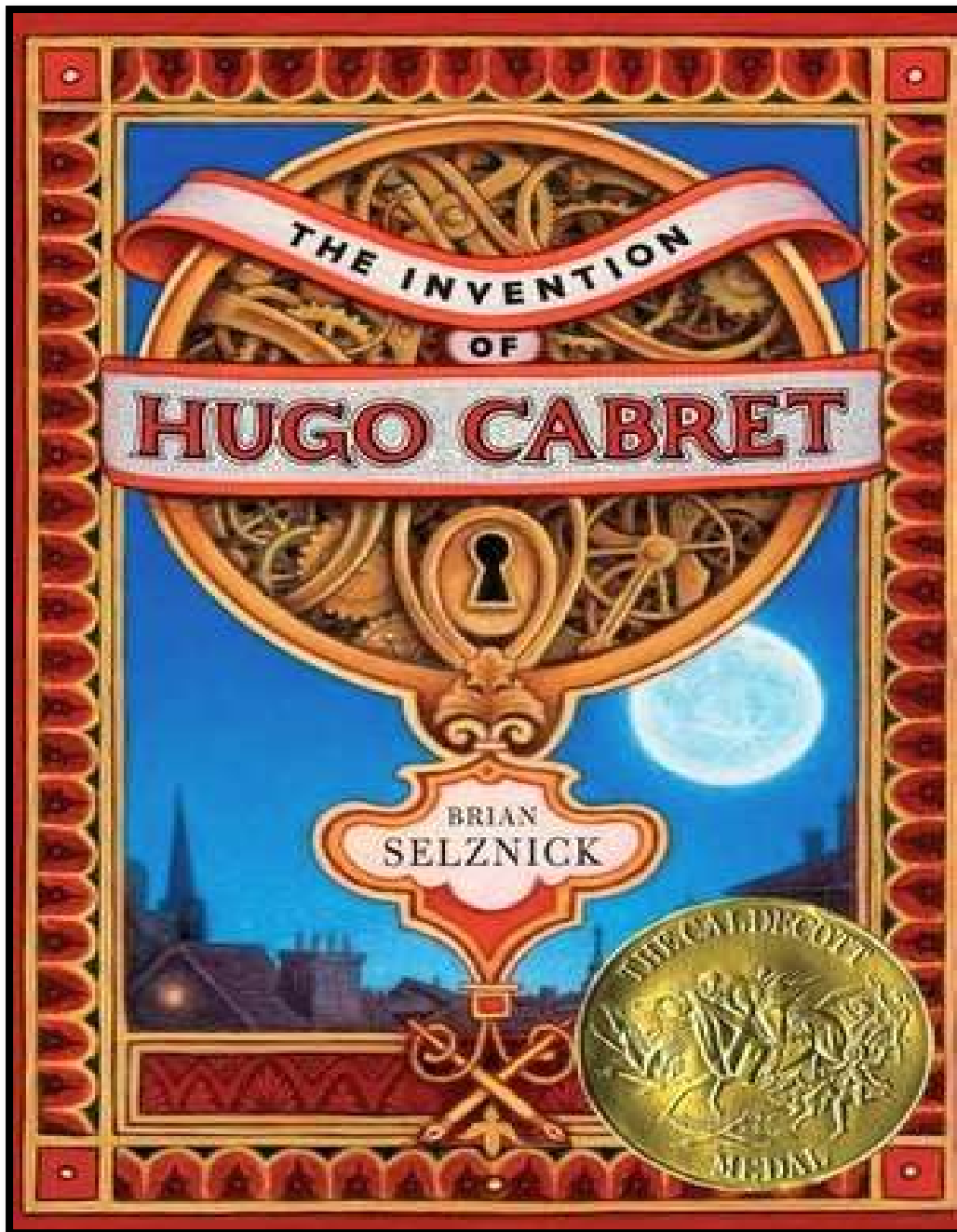
### **GOVERNING BODY RECRUITMENT**

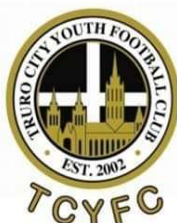
