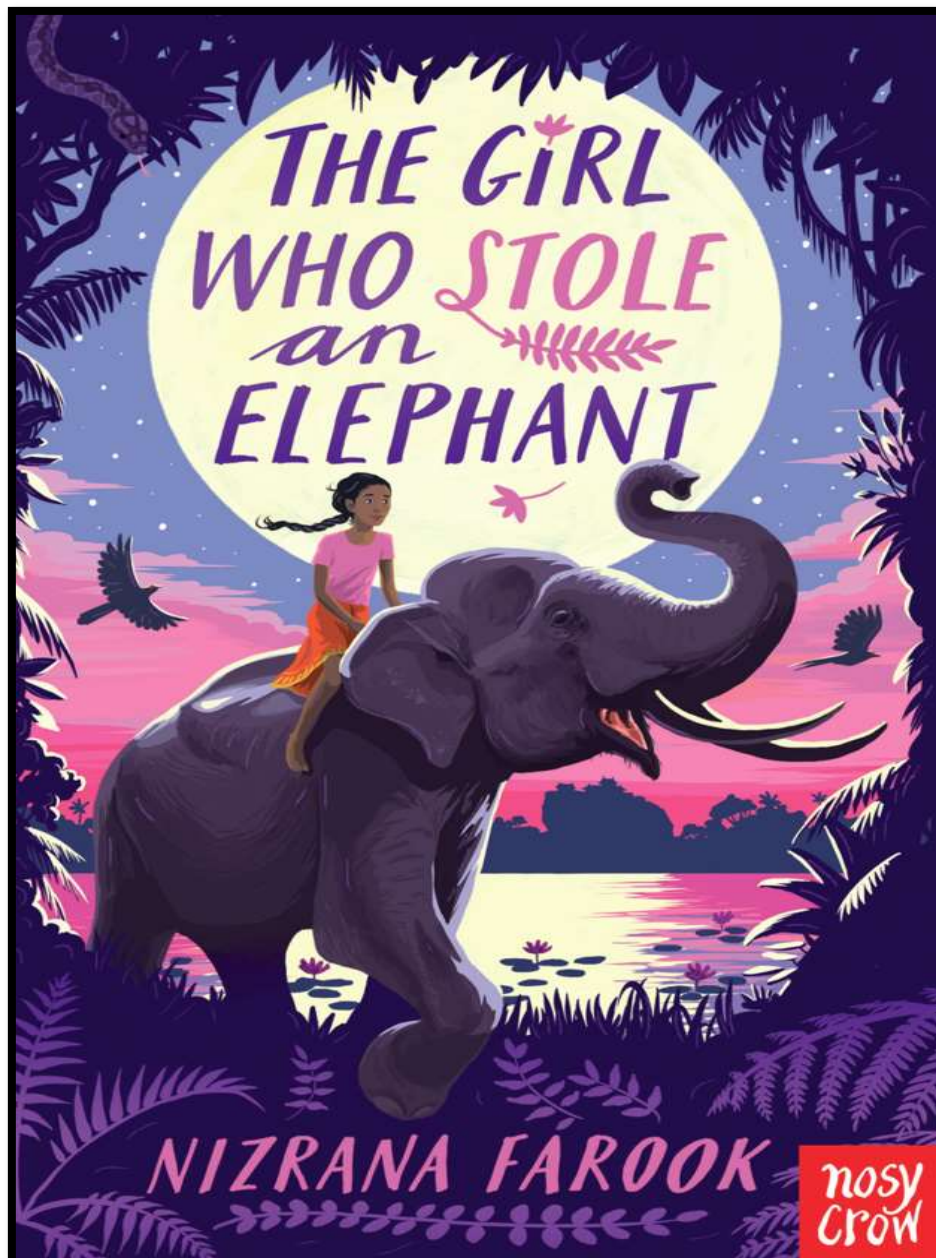
## MISS KEANE'S WEEKLY BOOK REVIEW

A fun adventure with a young Robin Hood type heroine, who pilfers from the rich to help the poor. When she goes too far in her pilfering, and takes some of the queen's jewels, she sets in motion a chain of events that involves elephant stealing, danger to her friends and family, a perilous journey through the jungle, and ultimately the overthrow of the tyrannical king.

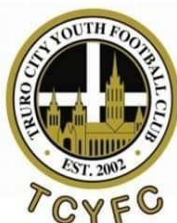
